Medals **Medals** will be awarded for first, second, and equal third in each event. There will also be **Certificates for all participants** in the Jubilee Foil & Epee Competitions.

Equipment Lamé bibs are required for all fencers competing with a size 5 blade, this includes the jubilee foil. Fencers must wear safe, correct kit that conforms to CEN level 1, and British Fencing rules. Breeches are compulsory. Under 10s must use size 0 and under 12s and 14s must use size 3 or smaller. U14 & U12 Epee size 2, U10's size 0. Neither British Fencing nor Trinity School, nor the organisers of the competition, nor any official or referee involved in the competition is responsible for these matters, or for any accident, loss or damage to persons or property however caused.

BFA Membership of the British Fencing Association is **compulsory**. If a BFA number is not included on the entry form we receive please bring evidence of your membership. Guidance on the new BFA membership can be found here: www.britishfencing.com/membership/. In line with the new BFA membership system, all competing must have a Compete level membership. We are **not able** to accept Starter or Recreational level memberships.

Referees The organisers would be very grateful for any assistance that can be provided in terms of referees and setting up, especially on the Saturday morning with the Jubilee foil. Please get in touch if you are able to assist.

Safety Whilst H&W CFU make every attempt to ensure that the event takes places safely in a safe and secure way, the responsibility for the safety and welfare of young fencers remains with the parent, or nominated responsible adult who is acting in loco parentis for that child. If you, as a parent or coach, bring a child to this event and leave them during the day, you must make sure the organisers are aware of the identity of the responsible adult who is looking after that child.

Region Boundaries in the West Midlands are often fluid as many coaches and fencers fence and reside within different counties. The organisers are happy to accept entries from fencers with a connection to H&W through coach, school, club or address.
